

The Preliminary SAT (PSAT) is a mode for high school sophomores and juniors to achieve their college goals. It measures reading, writing and language, and math skills. After the test, students receive feedback on college readiness along with tools for improvement. Advantages of taking the PSAT include:

- Personalized online practice tailored to the student's strengths and weaknesses
 - An interactive score report with answer explanations for SAT practice questions and full-length tests
 - Detailed feedback on the student's progress
 - Detailed personality test to assist in finding majors and careers that fit the student's talents and interest

 - Eligibility for junior students in the National Merit Scholarship Program
