State Mandated Assessments

• STAAR

The STAAR program encompasses STAAR, STAAR Spanish, and STAAR Alternate 2. STAAR focuses on increasing postsecondary readiness of graduating high school students and helps to ensure that Texas students are competitive with other students both nationally and internationally.

- STAAR grades 3–8 includes assessments of writing, reading, mathematics, science, and social studies. STAAR EOC assessments are available for Algebra I, Biology, English I, English II, and U.S. History.
- STAAR Spanish is available in grades 3–5 for each subject area assessed when Spanish provides the most appropriate measure of academic achievement.

The Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS) is designed to assess the progress that limited English proficient (LEP) students make in learning the English language. TELPAS measures English language proficiency in the following domains:

- Grades K-1 reading, listening, speaking, and writing.
- Grades 2–12 writing
- Grades 2-12 reading, listening, and speaking assessed online
